Psalm 23 is probably the most well-known and read, recited and sung psalm of all 150 in the Bible. It is a reassuring, comforting poem, reminding us we are not alone and need not fear anything at all. We are blessed people, well cared for. "The Lord is my shepherd; I shall not want". I shall not want? Have you ever met anyone who did not want anything? Have you lived a single day without wanting something? We always want things. We want good things, we want to forget mistakes we made, and we want to escape the consequences of things we wanted which were not so good after all.

What would it be like to live without 'want'? We are not instructed by the Scriptures to live without passion, desire, motivation, effort, or even want – but want of what? Want of a closer relationship with the Shepherd? Want of a deeper trust in the One who promises to take care of our every want, our every need? Want of a faith that tells us that everyone and everything has a purpose in life? Want of a greater understanding of the often-mysterious Biblical texts? "I shall not want". When we find ourselves wanting, does that mean that God is not living up to the promise to provide all we need? Think for a moment about the people you see on the benches in the shopping centre, especially on a very hot or cold day. The lonely men dressed in worn out pants and t-shirts, who don't
