

# Uniting Church in Australia Albany Region Congregations

#### Pentecost 10

Many people have made choices to live as if God does not exist. They do not recognize God's grace which has been given to all: simple things like the sun shining on all and the rain falling on all and the air that everyone breathes. Many people continue to do what they think is right in their sight; they rely on their strength and ability to do things and ignore the presence and power of God in everything they do. Today's Psalm states that anyone who said in their heart that there is no God is a fool, "Fool" here does not indicate a lack of intellectually ability, but rather, a moral and ethical inadequacy, as verse 3 indicates. Perhaps people today are not much different from the time of the psalmist. Many still struggle to know the presence of God in their lives, finding it difficult to believe not because there is no evidence, but because they are settled and comfortable and do not want to change their lifestyle. If there is no God, they reason, then there is no judgement, no accountability for their actions and no standard of right or wrong. This is the folly that the psalmist sees: people who prefer to live by their own decisions, who are corrupt(v1), perverse (v3) and ignorant(v4). The poverty of this way of life is contrary to the intentions of God for all people.
