

for ourselves, and for people who are doing it tough. The Denmark Uniting Church has been and is supporting a group of volunteers, the Homeless Project Denmark (HPD). The group has use of a purposely built shed on the Church's property, and receives some financial support from the congregation every month as well. Homelessness has changed in recent years. We don't see so many people sleeping 'under the bridge' anymore. That does not mean there are no longer homeless people, actually, today, there are more people without a place to call home than a decade ago. People sleep in tents in the bush, live in their cars, or stay with different friends or relatives for a time (known as couch surfing). As we all know, there are very few rental homes available, at rents people cannot afford, even when they do have one income. So people share, sometimes over a dozen people live in a small one-bathroom home. The HPD offers support by finding places for people to live, restoring caravans, finding furniture, etc. They store clothing, bedding etc. in the shed, as well as food. Every week about a dozen cardboard boxes with fresh food supplies go out to people living in overcrowded places, or people struggling to pay rent and bills and food as well. There is no government funding for this project, so everything the group can pass on is donated. Every Sunday, at the Denmark markets, the group has a stall with – also donated – items for sale. This stall is the HPD's main
