

Trinity Sunday

The Spirit brings nothing less than everything God has done in Jesus (v.13). Listening to the Spirit, to understand the things Jesus has to say, is what the church calls Theology, with its tools including prayer, bible study, reading, thinking, discussion: meditation, lecto divina, eucharist; plus song, dance, painting, stitching, fasting and serving. What do we hear? That the Triune God is an active God, coming, going, returning, sending, receiving, hearing and speaking. The Trinity has been described as harmonious song and dance! But this God is always open: embracing humankind within the whole creation, comforting, defending, encouraging, uniting. God's "everything" is "glory" (ch.17). Christ glorifies God, by following God's way to the end, even death. God glorifies Christ by raising him into the glory that he shared within the Triune God before the creation (17:4-5; 1:1-5). The Spirit glorifies Jesus by declaring and sharing Christ's glory with us (16:14; 17:22). The glory of God with which we glow leads us to perfect joy (16:20-22) wrapped in divine love (17:23-26).
