Greetings to you all on this, the 48th Anniversary of the formation of the Uniting Church in Australia. For those who were part of that formation process of bringing together the proud uniting congregations of Methodist, Presbyterian and Congregational Churches, there was great excitement for a very brave ecumenical venture decades in the making.

Nearly half a century later the world - and indeed the church - is a very different place. The role of the church in society is greatly diminished from what it once was. We live in a different sort of Australia where less than 50% of the nation's population openly espouse religious engagement, whether it be Christianity, or another of the many faith traditions that form the fabric of our contemporary society.

However, we are not a people without hope. As our Gospel for today emphasises (Luke 8:26-39) we are still very much in the business of naming and casting out the destructive demons and forces of evil that shatter people's lives. It is, after all at the core of our calling; to be distinctively different, rather than a pale reflection of a society increasingly resistant to Jesus' message of "Good News". We can choose to be *"distinctively different"*, which after all was the founding hope of the Uniting Church from its very beginnings.

I found the following when looking through the 1967 copy of "The Friendship Book".

She stood alone, shivering, pale, wide-eyed. Many folk hurried across the bridge in the heart of London, all bending before the bitter wind, but the ill-clad child remained motionless.

At last one of the hurrying crowd paused, peered at the wan, thin face, noted the hands were blue with cold, and saw the bewilderment and panic lurking in those wide eyes. He was a young doctor from Ireland, and there, on a London bridge he asked one simple question – "What are you doing here?"

"Waiting for God", was the curious reply.

"But why out here?" The man's voice was gentle.

"Father is dead," said the child. "Mother just died too, but before she died she told me that God would take care of me and that I must wait for Him. I've waited for Him at home for ages and He didn't come, so now I've come out to look for Him."

Moved to tears, the young doctor said in a choking voice, "And now you have found Him!"

That could have been regarded as blasphemous, but it wasn't meant to be – and in a way it was true. Gently the young doctor led the small child to his own home, gave her warmth, food and comfort and promised her security. He kept his promise for he was the founder of Dr Barnardo's Homes.

It was on a London bridge one freezing cold night that the mighty work began.
