

Pentecost Sunday

Recently as I watched whales breaching offshore, I remembered this psalm for its delight in the natural world and its sense of praise for the complexity of life. The Hebrew of v.26 can mean "that you formed just for the fun of it". Think of God's creativity. Look at a birdwing butterfly, an iridescent beetle or a coral reef fish and tell me God didn't have fun with creation. The Spirit is hidden here at v. 30. The breath of God, like the wind/ breath in Genesis is the Spirit at work, constantly renewing life in the creation, which is itself mortal, ephemeral, temporary in its parts. The Spirit who is in intimate relationship with Jesus, who confronts, teaches, enlivens us, is as close to creation, as God's breath. Creation pants and trembles, shivering with anticipation at God's touch. Finally: what do you make of the last verse? (read it all) We are coy about wishing destruction on our enemies; but amen to every power that restrains the wicked vandalism of God's good earth.

Psalm 104:24-35

How many are your works, Lord! In wisdom you made them all; the earth is full of your creatures. There is the sea, vast and spacious, teeming with creatures beyond number—living things both large and small. There the ships go to and fro, and Leviathan, which you formed to frolic there.

All creatures look to you to give them their food at the proper time. When you give it to them, they gather it up; when you open your hand, they are satisfied with good things.

When you hide your face, they are terrified; when you take away their breath, they die and return to the dust.

A prayer: I will not fear

"My Lord God, I have no idea where I am going, I do not see the road ahead of me, I cannot know for certain where it will end. Nor do I really know myself, and the fact that I think I am following your will does not mean that I am actually doing so. But I believe that the desire to please you does in fact please you.

And I hope I have that desire in all that I am doing. I hope that I will never do anything apart from that desire.

And I know that if I do this you will lead me by the right road,

though I may know nothing about it.
Therefore, I will trust you always,
though I may seem to be lost and in the shadow of
death.

I will not fear, for you are ever with me, and you will never leave me to face my perils alone." From Thomas Merton *Thoughts in Solitude*
