Some Dutch Culture

The small historic city of Enkhuizen is well worth spending some time at. Granted city rights in 1356, it developed from a small farming and fishing community into a wealthy fortified international trade centre, with more inhabitants in the 17th century than it has today. This is a view of part of the harbourfront this summer.



The city as a regional historic museum, with an outdoor area the size of a real village, and a fascinating indoor area as well. Work on the outdoor museum started in 1948 and is continuing. Buildings – houses, warehouses, shops and workshops, and ships, have been transported to the site. All sort of trades and crafts are on display, with volunteers showing their skills in fishnet production and maintenance, rope making, basket weaving, etc. You can admire a working eel smokery, a smithy, a bakery, a sweets shop, apothecary and laundry, the latter operated with a steam engine. Even a church was 'imported' from a nearby town, including the gravestones inside and around it.





Spring Rains

The prophet Hosea encouraged the ancient Israelites to "... press on to know the Lord; ... he will come to us like the showers, like the spring rains that water the earth."

In the land where Jesus lived and told his rural stories, grains like wheat, were sown in Autumn, grew in Winter, ripened in Spring and were harvested in early Summer. In the same way farmers in our South West corner of Australia know that, in a climate such as ours, Autumn, Winter and Spring rains are essential to a good harvest. One result is that we followers of Jesus in Albany readily understand why the most frequent image of Jesus 'resurrection in the Bible is not the green shoots of 'new birth 'emerging in Spring, but the gathering of the 'firstfruits' in early Summer, as assuring an abundant coming harvest. In this season of creation, the following prayer uses the pattern of a West Coast Mediterranean climate to ask God - Creator, Son and Spirit - to bless us with his love.

Let us pray to the God of germination, growth and fruitfulness:

Fecund God
Open our hearts in Jesus
Send the gentle Autumn rains
To germinate the seeds of love in us
Send the drenching Winter rains
So your love may grow strong in us
Send the late Spring rains
To ripen the fruits of your Spirit in us
Then may our lives may be blessed
With a bountiful summer harvest of love
Shared in joyful celebration
With all creation.
