

Warmth

With the heater going on 20th November, I wonder how people spend their day indoors when the weather is as foul as it is today. One of the things I do – apart from working – is read, and read some more, read poetry. Some poems leave me warmer than before I read them.

Here is one by R.S. Thomas that has that effect on me. I hope it will warm your heart too.

'Destinations' is its title.

"Travelling towards the light we were waylaid by darkness; a formless company detained us, saying everything, meaning nothing.

It is a conspiracy, I said, of great age, in revolt against reason, against all that would be ethereal in us. We looked at one another. Was it the silence of agreement, or the vacuum between two minds not in contact?

In thought that is its own hindrance. Had we come all that way to detect it? The voices combined urging us to put our trust in the bone's wisdom. Remember, they charged us, the future for which you are bound is where you began.

A Life Philosophy

We are each responsible for all of our experiences.

Every thought we think is creating our future. The point of power is always in the present moment. Most can suffer from a lack of self-esteem or guilt. The bottom line for everyone is, "I am not good enough". It is only a thought, and a thought can be changed.

We can create most so-called illness in our body. Resentment, criticism and guilt are the most damaging patterns. Releasing resentment can dissolve even cancer. We need to release the past and forgive all we can. We need to be willing to begin to learn to love ourselves as God loves us.

Self-approval and self-acceptance through the help of the Holy Spirit in the now are the keys to positive changes. When we really love ourselves and others (with a sacrificial love) that love is returned to us (the love of God).
